Providing for our Neighbors

Yvonne Bradley moved into the Worthington Resource Pantry's eight zip code service area in Spring of 2023. She was receiving \$29.30 in monthly Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) benefits and struggling to make it stretch to get the healthy food she needed. While being new to the neighborhood, she was also challenged with not having a car. This is when her neighbors told her about the Worthington Resource Pantry. After some quick online research, something Yvonne prides herself in, she signed up for her first homebound delivery in May.

"The Pantry saved my life," she said. "I'm stubborn and don't like to ask for help, but God told me I needed to."

Homebound delivery helps neighbors, like Yvonne, overcome obstacles in gaining access to fresh, healthy food, due to transportation problems, limited mobility, and lack of availability during open pantry hours.

"I thank you all for helping me sustain what I don't have. Just think if you didn't. Just think if you all didn't deliver - how many people wouldn't have a nutritious meal."

Yvonne is one of 1,750 families that the Worthington Resource Pantry delivers food to each year. Every delivery is individually packaged by dedicated volunteers and delivered through a partnership with DoorDash.

Yvonne was once introduced to the Worthington Resource Pantry and now she is the one spreading the word to her friends and neighbors.

"They are friendly, helpful, and my belly is full," she said with a smile.

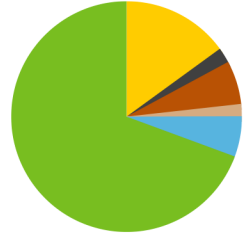

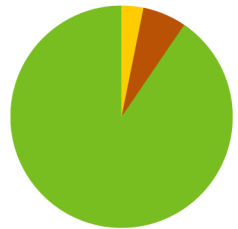
